What Should I Collect and Send?

Send us anything that captures the events that are unfolding and your/the community's response. This may include:

- Photographs
- Videos

- Materials that document remote learning or remote work
- Materials that document your routine or hobbies while you stay at home

How Do I Share Materials With HSP?

Email digital files to <u>share@princetonhistory.org</u>. Please include an explanation of what the materials are as well as the date from which they originate.

Files should not exceed 10 MB. If you would like to contribute a larger file, please contact us first.

What Will Happen to Materials That I Send?

We will send you a Deed of Gift form to give the Historical Society permission to use the material you send in future exhibitions, publications, and other educational programs. You will retain copyright to your words, images, and art.

If there are any people pictured in photographs, we will also send you a photograph consent form to get the consent of the individuals photographed to be pictured for educational purposes in the future.
